## — *Tertiary Pairing Project*

Wearable Art Mandurah invites Tertiary students from across Australia and internationally to participate in a collaborative process, designed to stretch their creativity and learn about working with artists from different backgrounds. The students are invited to be inspired by this year's conceptual category theme—*Elemental*.

Tertiary students participating in this program should be nominated by the teaching staff at their institution, who will facilitate the collaborative process with regular meetings with their counterpart. The teachers and students will be supported by Wearable Art Mandurah's Youth and Tertiary Coordinator.

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### **Benefits of getting involved**

There are many great reasons to get involved with the Tertiary Pairing Project:

- Select pairings chosen to appear in Wearable Art Mandurah Showcase and Exhibitions
- Potential to raise your artistic profile
- Chance to learn from designers from other countries or backgrounds
- Opportunity to expand your creative network and develop future partnerships
- Professional photos provided for your portfolio

### **Who can participate?**

The Tertiary Pairing Project is open to any student enrolled in a tertiary institution in 2022. It is recommended that participating students should be self-driven, passionate about design and open to working with other students. Students wishing to enter this program must do so with the support of their teacher/lecturer.

### **The role of the teacher**

This program is most successful with support from teachers on both ends. Teachers should plan on assisting students to establish contact with their partner, create a design and construction timeline and work to the competition deadlines.



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## How to get involved?

Registering for the Tertiary Pairing Project is easy! Simply head to the Wearable Art Mandurah website and complete the entry form, ensuring that you select 'Tertiary Pairing Project' as your category. Also please be sure to include your teacher's details in the form.

You will then be required to provide 1-2 pages of supplementary information to Wearable Art Mandurah, in order to be paired with another tertiary student

This document must include

- Maximum 150 words outlining your motivation to create wearable art
- Maximum 150 words describing your artistic aspirations
- Maximum 150 words explaining your interpretation of the theme 'Elemental'
- Images and text that show your sources of inspiration
- Two clear images of your best work (fashion/wearable art preferred)

**This information must be sent to both email addresses below by Friday 18 March.**

You will be paired with your partner within one week of entries closing, and can then proceed to complete your garment by the Pre-Selection Submission deadline. More information on the Competition Timeline can be found on the Wearable Art Mandurah website.
