We are calling out for performers of any age, background and experience to join us on stage for the 2022 Wearable Art Mandurah Showcase performance at Mandurah Performing Arts Centre (ManPAC) in October. This is a volunteer opportunity to perform dance and movement group routines alongside our professional performers and models.

Experience level is not important. We are on the lookout for positive, friendly and collaborative volunteer cast members who will enjoy being part of this unique local performance extravaganza.

What to expect?

All volunteer cast members will have the opportunity to participate in a 5-minute dance and movement scene in the finale of the Wearable Art Mandurah Showcase. Prior dance experience isn't required, however unique skill-sets, training and experience can be included if you'd like to contribute them to the scene.

Volunteer cast members over 18 years may also be included in a 3-minute dance scene requiring the ability to remember specific choreographic steps. The movement will be relatively simple, but some dance experience would be beneficial for this opportunity.

There may be other small dance and movement roles available for the Showcase, which volunteer cast-members may be approached for as well!

This is a fun and unique performance opportunity to work alongside a professional production team! Benefits include:

- Excellent work experience if you are considering a future training in and performing at a professional level.
- Opportunity to meet and work with industry professionals from dance, modelling and production, or just to discover other like-minded individuals!
